


2024 Publix Gasparilla Half Marathon Staging Area



STAGING TIMES

Half Marathon Seeded Staging - Beginning at 5 a.m., Seeded Runners will access the Half Marathon start from the front and should utilize the seeded/elite entrance that's located on Bayshore Boulevard at the Finish Line/Half Marathon Start Line.
PLEASE NOTE: ACCESS TO BAYSHORE BOULEVARD AND THE HALF MARATHON CORRALS WILL CLOSE AT 5:45 A.M.

Half Marathon 2 Hours & Under - Runners should enter the Staging Area located on northbound lanes of Bayshore Boulevard. Once on Bayshore, please proceed south to Half Marathon Start Corrals which must be entered from a marked (2 Hours & Under) barricade break adjacent to the Bayshore Median. Participants will enter corral from the rear. If corral fills to capacity, participant will be directed to the second corral.
PLEASE NOTE: ACCESS TO BAYSHORE BOULEVARD AND THE HALF MARATHON CORRALS WILL CLOSE AT 5:45 A.M.

Half Marathon 2 Hours & Over - Runners should enter the Staging Area located on northbound lanes of Bayshore Boulevard. Once on Bayshore, please proceed south to Half Marathon Start Corrals which must be entered from a marked (2 Hours & Over) barricade break adjacent to the Bayshore Median. Participants will enter corral from the rear.
PLEASE NOTE: ACCESS TO BAYSHORE BLVD. AND THE HALF MARATHON CORRALS WILL CLOSE AT 5:45 A.M.

From the north: Tampa Convention Center & Downtown Tampa, Half Marathon participants will be directed to Bayshore Boulevard Staging by utilizing Platt Street Bridge (one lane will be closed for Half Marathon participants). Once over the bridge, participants will enter the staging area through a secure opening at Bayshore & Platt Street.

From the south: Half Marathon participants will be directed to a secure opening at Bayshore & Platt Street. Once on Bayshore, please refer to the appropriate Staging Directions listed above (2 Hours & Under or 2 Hours & Over).

Viewing Areas: Bleachers located on water side of Bayshore Boulevard at Half Marathon Start/Finish Line.
